- Ideal for internal walls or undercover/alfresco/protected eave ceilings and wall lining.
- Blackbutt and Spotted Gum are naturally termite resistant.
- Suitable for use in BAL 29 areas under Australian Standard AS 3959.
- Boral timber can be used internally and externally undercover to provide a seamless transition from inside to outside, expanding living areas or to create an outdoor room.
- Australian Hardwoods can be finished in multiple ways including pre oiling or coated on site.
- Manufactured from Australian timber that has proven durability in Australian conditions.
- Boral Timber Shiplap lining is Responsible Wood Chain of Custody certified providing peace of mind that Boral's lining is sourced from sustainably managed and legal forestry.
